I wanted to let you know what happened in court on March 5th. It was a brief appearance where the court made decisions as to what dates certain procedures during litigation must be completed. Among other things, our motion for a preliminary injunction hearing must be filed by June 4th. The court will assign a hearing date once the motion is filed. Depending on how the preliminary injunction hearing goes, the trial on the merits of this case is scheduled to begin January 31, 2011.

Regarding the outlook calendars, yes, please continue to use them. As noted earlier, the purpose of the documentation is to show what work you actually do during the day, as opposed to what the Department says you are doing. In particular, I am interested in seeing how much clinical work you do each day, whether the inmate appeals are being processed timely, whether you are able to keep yourself and the staff up on training, and whether you are able to keep attending the meetings the Chief Dentist attended, and if not, what meetings you are attending.

One more thing regarding the outlook calendars. Could you all send your copies to me by snail mail please? (My fax machine will appreciate that!) It would be helpful to send them at the end of each month. If you have any that have not been sent to me previously, I would appreciate you sending them now.
