**Parity Court Case - Rumor:** There have been rumors floating around that the CCSO Parity court case's decision was made and supervisors (S06) received money, etc. **This is just a Rumor.** Chief Operations & Financial Officer Le Sage spoke with Attorney Lackie and there has not been a decision made on the CCSO appeal. Attorney Lackie informed Le Sage that the appeal court date is scheduled for July 18<sup>th</sup>; therefore, no decision will be made until after the 18<sup>th</sup> of July. The CCSO office will get the news of the decision out to the membership, as soon as we receive word on it from our attorneys.

**RJD Inmate Dies:** Friday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>, an inmate was stabbed to death by another inmate at RJD in San Diego. The stabbing occurred as a group of 59 inmates were returning from their evening meal at the Otay Mesa-area penitentiary around 5 p.m. A lieutenant found a makeshift knife made from a piece of metal during a search of the area.

**CIM's Website:** CIM's Chapter Board Member Sgt. Quezada has provided to the CCSO office the memo for vacation bid schedules, post and bid results for sergeants, post and bid results for lieutenants, stand by cancellation request form, stand by vacation request form, and the annual (bid) vacation cancellation request form pertinent to CIM. He will be updating the post and bid results as they occur. Sgt. Quezada has asked CCSO to put the forms on the CIM website, which is linked to the CCSO website. **San Quentin Ceremony:** Chapter President Frank Cerecedes represented CCSO along with CDCR representatives at San Quentin on Wednesday, June 7<sup>th</sup> to remember the fallen officers. San Quentin was established in July 1852. The memorial was focused on the courage of so many fallen officers at San Quentin.

**McFarland, CCF Meet and Confer:** CCSO will meet and confer on June 9<sup>th</sup> over Community Correctional Facility McFarland's, medical coverage, sergeant positions, a payroll audit, and lack of contract compliance regarding the teaching staff. The McFarland Chapter President Lt. Brad Freeland will be in attendance for this meet and confer.

**CCPOA Memo re: Unit 6 Wage Increase:** CCSO received a CCPOA memorandum indicating that Unit 6 would receive a salary increase of 4.3% effective July 1, 2006 in addition to the 0.9% general salary increase effective June 30, 2006. CCSO will be meeting with DPA on June 22<sup>nd</sup> over salary increases affecting Unit 6 supervisors and managers. CCSO has been and continues to secure that these benefits will be moved over to Unit 6 supervisors and managers. Along with DPA, we have been communicating with the Governor's Office, this year, requesting additional raises be given to S06 supervisors and M06 managers, as well as all correctional excluded employees to correct the salary compaction.
