4. Short narrative about why you plan to attend college
5. Copy of high school transcripts
6. A letter of recommendation from two (2) teachers
7. A letter from two (2) personal friends

Application Deadline

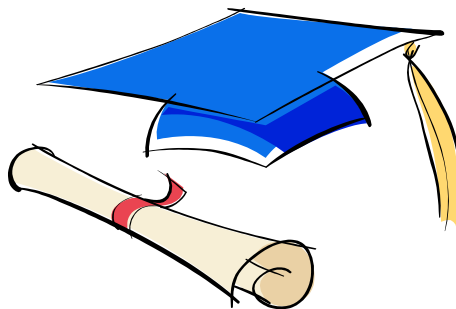
The deadline for submitting your scholarship application is April 30th. Applications postmarked after this date will not be included for consideration.
