The following changes are now updated on the electronic Pay Scales. Changes to the Alphabetical and Schematic Listings (Section 15) will be updated within the first week of each month.

GENERAL SALARY INCREASES

R06: (Effective 06/30/06 - BOB)

In compliance with an AGREEMENT BETWEEN the STATE OF CALIFORNIA and the above Bargaining Unit, the Department of Personnel Administration has approved a .9 percent GENERAL SALARY INCREASE. All classes designated R06 shall be increased by .9 percent. All employees designated R06 and E06 shall be entitled to the .9 percent increase.

DOCUMENTATION:

S06 (Effective 06/30/06 - BOB)

The Department of Personnel Administration has approved a .9 percent GENERAL SALARY INCREASE. All classes designated S06 shall be increased by .9 percent. All employees in the designated S06 classes shall be entitled to the .9 percent increase.

DOCUMENTATION:

The State Controller's Office will process an employment history mass update to implement the 06/30/06 effective date general salary increase for R06, E06, and S06 designated employees. A GEN transaction with a 06/30/06 effective date will result from the mass update process. The GEN transaction will also reflect the 06/30/06 effective date increase for the R06 Educational Incentive Pay Differential 44 per below Section 14: Pay Differentials.

Employees who separated from State service prior to 06/30/06 and have lump sum payments that extend beyond 06/30/06 shall have their lump sum payments adjusted to reflect the above general salary increase and below pay differential rate increase. The State Controller's Office will manually process a GEN transaction for the separated employees.

Turnaround (TAD) PARS will not be issued from the employment history update processes. These employment history processes will be combined with future mass updates that are being processed with a 07/01/06 effective date.

Once the GEN transaction is posted to an employee's EH record, any new out-of-sequence transactions must have salary rate entered if allowed on the transaction. If not entered, the salary rate information per the GEN transaction will be reflected on the new transaction and could create an overpayment situation. Also, any transactions entered with a 06/30/06 effective date (and sitting below the GEN) should have the GSI code O entered when allowable on the transaction. See PAM Section 9 for further processing information.

SECTION 05: HIRING ABOVE MINIMUM

R06 and S06 classes are increased to reflect a .9% GSI increase: (Effective 06/30/06 - BOB)

DOCUMENTATION: The State Controller's Office will process records with a plus salary manually to implement the 06/30/06 effective date general salary increase.

SECTION 14: PAY DIFFERENTIALS

1. PAY DIFFERENTIAL 44
EDUCATIONAL INCENTIVE PAY – UNIT 06 AND EXCLUDED EMPLOYEES is amended: (Effective 06/30/06 - BOB)

The rate for rank-and-file classes is increased to \$126.

2. PAY DIFFERENTIAL 60
FLIGHT-TIME DIFFERENTIAL PAY - UNIT 06 AND EXCLUDED EMPLOYEES is amended: (Effective 06/30/06- BOB)

The rate for rank-and-file classes is increased to \$206

DOCUMENTATION: The State Controller's Office will process an employment history mass update to increase the rate of pay differential Earnings ID: 8E6 for R06 designated employees. The rate increase will be reflected on the GEN transaction used to implement the above 06/30/06 effective date general salary increase.
