- Conventional Living Trusts are dangerous to use for guns because they do not provide on-the-fly versatility or specific guidance needed to protect the gun owner, trustee, or beneficiaries, nor do they provide updated state and federal laws.

Legally and Safely!

Did you know the term "TRANSFER" is broadly defined by the NFA to include selling, assigning, pledging, leasing, loaning, giving away, or otherwise disposing of an NFA firearm?

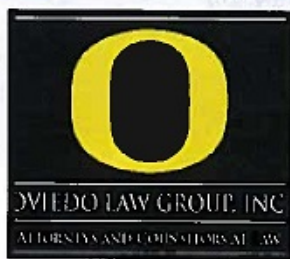
Did you know you could be committing an "accidental felony"? You May Be if....

- Transfer or make a firearm in violation of the NFA
- Receive or possess a firearm:
 - transferred or made in violation of NFA.
 - not registered to oneself in violation of the NFA.
- Obliterate, remove, change, or alter the serial number of a firearm.

A properly built gun trust:

- Holds legal title to regulated and non-regulated firearms.
- Provides legal benefits for those you select, and allowing only legal transfers of firearms by gift, sale, and "sharing".

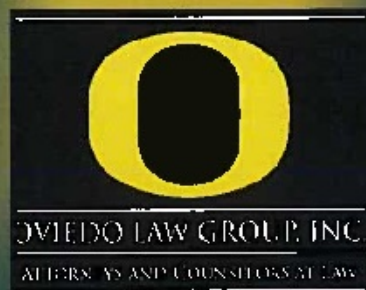
